Notice of Public Hearing on May 15, 2008, for Proposed Change to Paratransit Certification Process

On May 15, 2008 at 2:00 p.m. the North County Transit District (NCTD) Board will hold a Public Hearing in the Board Room of NCTD at 810 Mission Avenue, Oceanside, CA, to hear public comment about its proposed July 1, 2008 change to a web-based program for the paratransit certification process.

Applicants would no longer be required to have in-person eligibility interviews. Applications would be completed on-line, by phone, or by mail. Medical professionals will be evaluating the applications.
