Compass Card Verification on COASTER Scheduled for September 1, 2 & 3

Since the introduction of Compass cards in May for COASTER monthly pass holders, passengers and fare enforcement officers have had difficulty determining whether platform validators are properly validating cards. Beginning September 1, NCTD personnel and fare enforcement officers will be testing Compass cards at station validators in Oceanside, Carlsbad and Encinitas. The testing of passenger cards will provide valuable feedback on the Compass card program and whether validators and hand held units are working properly.

Beginning Tuesday, September 1 and running through Thursday, September 3, all COASTER monthly pass holders are asked to tap their Compass card at the platform validator as usual. A fare enforcement officer will then read the card with a hand held unit. If an inconsistency arises, personnel will jot down the number of the card for further evaluation. It is our goal to keep passenger inconvenience to a minimum. The information gathered from these verifications will allow NCTD and its regional partners in the Compass program to evaluate effectiveness.
