

THINKING ABOUT A PERS RETIREMENT?

IT CAN BE A SCARY IDEA!

GET INFORMATION AND MAKE GOOD DECISIONS ABOUT YOUR FUTURE!

You can't do any real retirement planning unless you know the PERS Estimated amount of your future monthly pension payment.

That calculation must come from PERS. You have to apply to PERS to receive this calculation.

You can go online and get an estimate, too – but to make real decisions on your future you should use the actual PERS calculation.

How do you get the PERS calculation?

You must complete a request to PERS.

You can go online for the Estimate application or contact PERS to have it mailed to you. You can apply for retirement at the same time.

PERS needs 30 days to provide your Pension Estimate, and 90 days to process your retirement application.

If you complete your application on line be sure to “log in” so the system automatically enters NCTD plan information for you.

There are 5 different options you can choose for your monthly pension.

These different options can be confusing.

You will need the PERS Estimate to make your decision.

To discuss pension options and complete your retirement application, PERS has FREE one-on-one appointments, retirement classes, fairs, and on-line classes.

You should attend to decide which pension option is best for you and your family. You can bring your spouse, too.

LAST STEP

After you:

- Have your PERS calculation
- Have decided on your pension option
- Have completed your retirement application

Then contact Annamarie Shields, Benefit Assistant at (760) 966-6553. Make an appointment to see Linda Elmore, Benefits Administrator. Bring your completed application with you.

Linda will complete the Employer section and review your application.

Then, you either mail or personally deliver your retirement application to PERS.
