NIGHT RAIL CONSTRUCTION PLANNED IN CARLSBAD

Amtrak is working to make improvements along the railroad tracks within the North County Transit District (NCTD) railroad right-of-way in Carlsbad. We anticipate working in your area:

Friday, Aug. 26, at 6 p.m. to Sunday, Aug. 28, at 6 p.m.

Construction will be focused on:

Tamarack Avenue at the rail road crossing, west of I-5. Please note that Tamarack Ave. will be temporarily closed to cars and pedestrians.

Because this is an active rail line, some of the track construction must be conducted in the evening. Construction crews will work to minimize noise impacts to residents and will direct lighting away from residential structures to the greatest extent possible.

Amtrak is working with SANDAG and NCTD to add a second track to the 60-mile LOSSAN coastal rail corridor in San Diego County to improve Amtrak and COASTER passenger rail services. As a companion to Interstate 5, the San Diego segment of the LOSSAN corridor plays a critical role in the movement of people and goods within the region's North Coast Corridor.
