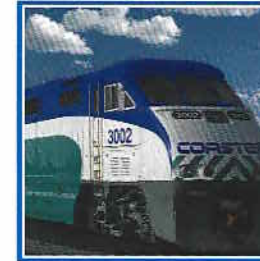

WHAT IS MOBILITY TRAINING?



Mobility training offers personalized one-on-one training to teach individuals with disabilities, seniors and ADA Paratransit riders

how to maneuver and operate their personal mobility device (wheelchair or scooter) independently on NCTD Breeze buses, SPRINTER and COASTER trains.

WHAT IS TRAVEL TRAINING?



Travel Training educates individuals how to navigate the NCTD public transit system safely and confidently throughout the local community.

PLACES TO GO ON THE BREEZE



NCTD BREEZE buses have over 40 routes to various destinations. You can travel to the North County Fair, the Wild Animal Park, the Flower Fields,

Plaza Camino Real shopping center, the Center for the Arts, University Towne Center and to most Senior Centers located in North County.

PLACES TO GO ON THE COASTER



NCTD's COASTER train serves eight stations from Oceanside Transit Center to Santa Fe Depot in downtown San Diego. Step aboard the

 - Your destination** (addresses or cross streets)
- Follow the instructions given by your trip planner to reach your destination.
